WHAT WE NEED TO KNOW

- ◆ Who is part of the project?
Function, short CV, incl. website/IG
- ◆ What is the transdisciplinary & socially engaged focus of the project?
Brief project description: what methods you intend to engage with, what you want to gain from the project. (150 words max.)
- ◆ A short motivation
How you wish to contribute inside the peer-frame work, how you want to sediment/ archive/ present your process, who you address with your work. (150 words max.)
- ◆ Which mentors could best support your project?
At least 2 proposals, Vienna-based, do not have to be Angewandte associated
- ◆ Preliminary time plan and intended use of the APL studio workspace
If a project doesn't need the APL studio space but rather a different space, please do let us know
- ◆ A brief insight into your current work via photo, video or audio examples

Cross-institute group submissions are prioritized. The project you are applying for should not have been realized before. The open call is primarily aimed at *Angewandte* students (BA, MA, PhD), exceptions for collaborators apply. The willingness to **attend group appointments** is a prerequisite for consideration. The submitted project **cannot be a ZKF/ Semesterproject**. The selection is made according to the available resources. The number of projects selected is based on necessity and division of resources. The amount of the project grant and studio space will be communicated during the interview and confirmed after acceptance. The subsidy will be paid out aliquot after the projects' completion. In case of urgency, the open call is subject to further modifications.

The selection is made by an external jury as well as the project coordination team **Charlotta Ruth** and **Timothy Nouzak** in collaboration with the *APL – Angewandte Performance Lab*, *HUFAK* and the *INTRA* research project “Archives in Practice”. The selection will be based on a number of different criteria connected to relevance and feasibility. Contentwise, we are open to a multitude of methods and practices.

By **March 15th 2023**, all finalists will be contacted by email and invited to an interview. After the interviews, the final decision will be made by March 20th 2023.
